Tom Gann Went to Oklahoma City . . .

... and Here's What Happened:

Two years ago, you sent Inola auditor Tom Gann to Oklahoma City.

He became the ONLY AUDITOR in the Legislature. Working on your behalf, it didn't take him long to find a **2.4 billion dollar surplus that was "supposed" to be used for education**; instead, in Tom's view, the custodians of the fund seemed more interested in building up, protecting and living off of the fund instead of sending the proceeds to common education.
